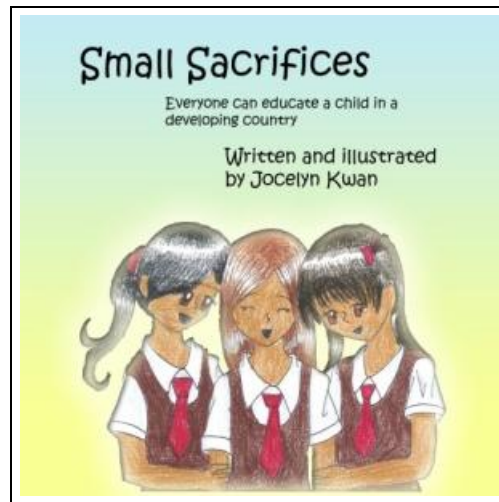

It is a good resource to promote International-Mindedness and empathy. The message is compelling as readers cannot close the book without realizing that they can make a huge difference by making a small sacrifice of a luxury or fun item and donating the proceeds to charity.
