A few micrometric observations of double stars and comets are made with the sixteen-inch refractor on nights unsuitable for photography. Daily photographs of the Sun have been taken whenever possible since 1889. The approximate measures of the photographs taken from 1889 to 1893 were published last summer in Publication No. 3 of Goodsell Observatory. There are on hand something like 1,200 solar photographs taken since 1893, which have not been measured because of the lack of the necessary funds for assistance, the time of the two professors being fully occupied with their duties in the instruction of the college classes, and the work of editing Popular Astronomy.
