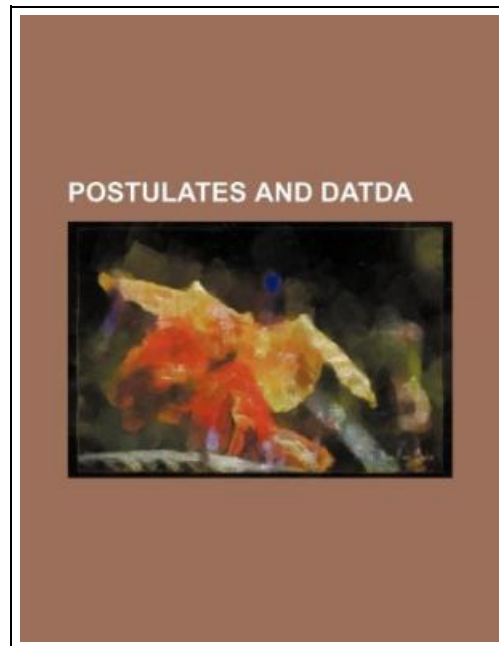

We should also add, with regard to his duties, that the founder wills and directs, nay, by the mercy of God implores the Dean and the Canons to be industrious in sovring the Word of God, in season and out of season, both elsewhere and particularly in the Cathedral Church, though the Canons are only required to preach there four times a year, by themselves or others, with the additional obligation upon the Dean of preaching by himself or deputy, on Easter Sunday, Whit Sunday, and Christmas Day. Sermons are also required to be preached (of course under the revised statutes,) on the anniversary of the Royal Accession, and the Fifth of November, by the Dean, or a Canon, or one of the six preachers, and on. Ascension Day the Archdeacon of Canterbury is to preach, whether a Canon or not. Their preaching duties then in the Cathedral being thus limited, the natural inference is that the Dean and Canons were expected to be very active in preaching and labouring elsewhere. We now give the original Latin of Cap. XIV. of the Statutes, which contains the foregoing regulations, and is intituled De Concionibus in Ecclesia nostra habendis. Quia Lucerna pedibus nostris est verbum Dei, Statuimus et volumus ut Decanus et Canonici nostri (immo per misericordiam Dei obsecramus) in...
